Arnold Lindley Jr., 66, of Pennsauken, passed away on July 6, 2014. He was born in Philadelphia to the late Arnold Lindley Sr. and Dorothy (nee Smith) Lindley. Arnold received his PhD from Hofstra University and went on to work as a Psychologist. He was the Director of Special Services for Tabernacle School System, the past President of NJASP and was awarded School Psychologist of the year. Arnold was very active in the church and was a deacon at the First Baptist Church of Merchantville, before becoming a parishioner of the First Baptist Church of Collingswood.
