I am not doing the memory justice at all. It was very fun and funny and one of my favorite memories of him. Mike always acted tough but he did keep an eye out for all the kids in the neighborhood. If someone was picking on another, and Mike saw it would step in and stop it. Tell the bully to leave the other kid alone. He didn't like bullies...and he let them know it. More then one kid ran when they saw Mike come storming out of the house. Once he gave me, and a girlfriend, I believe it was Stephanie who lived in the neighborhood, a ride to the mall in his old dodge van. We were waiting for the 101 bus at Westfield and Lexington. It was winter and we were freezing waiting...he pulled up and said "don't stand there and freeze, get in"...he then proceeded give us a "stern" lecture about not going to the mall to meet up with boys..which we probably were going to do...it was funny, but he was just trying to keep us safe. I will always appreciate him for that...trying to keep us safe.

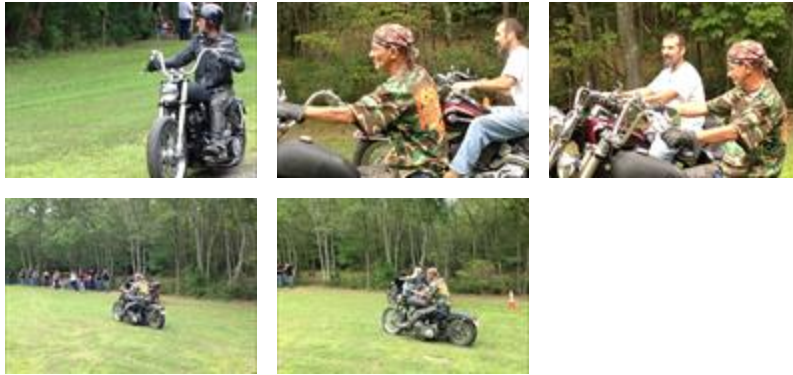
